Materials List

- Compressed Charcoal soft, med, and hard
- Vine charcoal sticks one package (soft or medium)
- Drawing pencils, 2H, HB, 2B, 4B (about 2 each)
- Pad of newsprint, 18" x 24", 100 sheets
- Pad of multipurpose drawing paper, 18" x 24", approx. 80+ lbs., 50 sheets
- Sketchbook, 9" x 12" approx. size, hard or spiral bound (You can make your own if you would prefer. This can be as basic as a clipboard and a couple hundred sheets of photocopy paper)
- Masking tape, painters' tape or artists' tape
- Erasers, White plastic or white pearl, pink pearl, and kneaded
- -Sharpies or permanent markers, 3 – 5. Thin, thick, and/or chisel tips. Or a set of 6+ black Micron art pens
- Portfolio with handles, 19" x 25" or larger for transporting drawings and pads
- 18" or 24" ruler, cork-back preferred
- -9" x 12" cardboard or mat board (cereal boxes work fine)
- Exacto knife, box cutter or scissors
- -Conte Crayons/chalk, red, brown, black and white
- -Water jar(s) or container(s), small plastic containers with a resealable lid (i.e. baby food, tupperware, etc.)
- -Toolbox, tackle box or plastic container for storing supplies
- -Paintbrushes: round and flat, for ink and watercolor/watermedia
- -Your choice of color media (watercolor, colored pencils, pastels)
- -India ink (1 oz.), bamboo brushes, ink/bamboo pens (we have some class supplies, but you may have to share, so you might want to bring your own.)
- Pencil Sharpener that holds shavings
